

Dubai Mission JULY 17-27, 2026



Greetings in the precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ!

We thank the Lord for His abundant grace, protection, and guidance throughout our recent mission trip to the United Arab Emirates. It is with grateful hearts that we present this report of what the Lord has done during our ministry from July 17 to July 27, 2026.

This mission trip was undertaken by Pastor Roshan Masih, Brother Piyush, and my younger son Brother Moses. We are especially thankful that this was Brother Moses' first missionary journey. It was a valuable opportunity for him to witness God's work firsthand and gain practical experience in evangelism and Christian ministry. We pray that the Lord will continue to lead and use him for His glory.



The purpose of our visit was to strengthen believers, minister the Word of God, encourage Indian families living and working in the UAE, fellowship with pastors and believers, and reach people with the End-Time Message. Throughout the trip, the Lord opened many doors for ministry. We conducted services in labour camps, visited believers in their homes, met with ministers for fellowship and Bible discussions, prayed for families, and shared the Gospel with many who were hungry for the Truth.

A Faithful Brother Embracing Present Truth

During our previous mission trip to Dubai in 2024, we had the privilege of meeting **Brother Ashwani Kumar**, an associate pastor in a Punjabi Pentecostal Church, along with several believers from his congregation. We introduced him to the End-Time Message, and from the very beginning he demonstrated a sincere, humble and learning spirit. As we shared the Scriptures, he carefully listened and gladly received the truths concerning the Godhead and the End-Time ministry before the Rapture.

After our return, we remained in regular fellowship with Brother Ashwani through phone calls and messages. Over the months, we continued to answer his questions, encourage him from the Scriptures, and help him grow in





the understanding of Present Truth. It has been a joy to witness his spiritual hunger and steadfast desire to follow the Word of God. On this recent mission trip, Brother Ashwani organized a special meeting for us in his church. During our visit, he made the important decision to be re-baptized in the Name of the Lord Jesus Christ. Another sincere believer from his church, **Brother Ram Parvez**, also followed the Lord in baptism.

At present, Brother Ashwani has not made this decision public within his church, believing that the Lord will provide the right time to do so. Meanwhile, he is prayerfully and wisely helping other believers understand these precious Biblical truths. His burden is not to



create confusion but to patiently lead sincere hearts into a deeper revelation of God's Word.

Brother Ashwani is a humble, faithful, and God-fearing servant who genuinely loves the Lord and desires to walk in all the light that God has revealed. We thank the Lord for His work in this precious brother's life.

Worship Service at Brother Ashwani's Church

We were greatly blessed to have the opportunity to minister in Brother Ashwani's church. The congregation is made up of believers from different parts of India who are living and working in Dubai. In addition, several brothers and sisters from Kenya also attend the same church. Since Kenya



believers understand English only, Moses, faithfully interpreted the message into English while I preached in Punjabi.

The church also has several believers from Pakistan, particularly from the Punjab region, who were able to understand the message in Punjabi. The Lord wonderfully blessed the service, and the people listened with great interest and appreciation.



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At the conclusion of the service, we received a warm invitation from the church to return and minister again in the future. Several families from the same congregation also invited us to visit their homes for further fellowship. Although they warmly invited us to visit their homes for fellowship, our schedule was too limited to meet everyone during this trip. We collected their contact

information and promised to visit them on our next mission trip, which we hope will take place soon, Lord willing. We look forward to spending more time with these precious believers, answering their questions, sharing the Word, and strengthening them in the faith.

We thank the Lord for opening this door of fellowship and ministry, and we pray that He will continue to establish His Word in the hearts of His people.

Visiting Believer Families

During our mission trip, we had the privilege of visiting three

Indian families who believe the End-Time Message and are living and working in the UAE. Two families were in Dubai, and one family was in Abu Dhabi.

These families have made the UAE their temporary home for employment while faithfully serving the Lord and raising their families according to God's Word. It was a great joy to spend time with them in Christian fellowship, sharing the Scriptures, praying together, and encouraging them to remain steadfast in the faith.

Our visits provided an opportunity to answer questions from the Word of God, strengthen their faith, and encourage them to continue standing for the Truth despite the challenges of living in a foreign country. We were greatly encouraged by their love for the Lord, their commitment to the Message, and their desire to see others come to the knowledge of the Truth.

We thank God for opening the doors to fellowship with these precious families and pray that He will continue to bless, protect, and use them as shining lights for His Kingdom in the UAE.

Fellowship with Believers in the Labour Camps

One of the most touching experiences of our mission trip was visiting the labour camps, where thousands of workers from different parts of India live and work. We were deeply moved by the difficult living conditions. To our surprise, as many as eight men were sharing a single small





room. Yet, in the midst of these hardships, we found believers who were holding firmly to their faith.

Our burden was to gather all the Message believers from Punjab who were living in different labour camps and bring them together for a time of fellowship. We selected one labour camp that was convenient for everyone to reach, and

many of the brothers took a day's leave from work so they could attend. We spent the entire day with them in fellowship, prayer, and sharing the Word of God.

We encouraged them to meet together every Sunday for regular fellowship, prayer, and the study of God's Word, even when we are not present. We also



discussed beginning a weekly Zoom fellowship every Friday, and all the brothers gladly agreed. This will help keep them united and strengthen them spiritually. It will allow us to remain in regular contact so that we can continue

encouraging and teaching them from a distance.



We believe this is an important step toward establishing a strong fellowship among the believers in Dubai. We pray that the Lord will continue to bless and preserve this growing group for His glory.

A Fruitful Fellowship with Pastor Prashant Carlo

One of the highlights of our mission trip was our fellowship with **Pastor Prashant Carlo** from Abu Dhabi. We had been in contact with him for a long time through phone calls and WhatsApp. Sharing with him the glorious Message of the Hour. Pastor Prashant already believed in the Oneness of God and had been baptized in the Name of the Lord Jesus Christ. However, he had many sincere questions regarding several Bible doctrines, particularly the Second Coming of Christ and other teachings revealed through the ministry of Brother William Branham. His greatest objection was the doctrine of the Serpent Seed. Because of misunderstandings surrounding this teaching, he had developed a strong prejudice against Brother Branham and the Message.



During our visit, Pastor Prashant kindly invited us to his home. We spent several hours in prayerful fellowship and Bible discussion, continuing our conversation until midnight. By the grace of God, we were able to answer his questions one by one from the Scriptures and explain the Message in its proper context. It was a great joy to hear him say at the end of our discussion, "I now agree with the Serpent Seed doctrine." This was a significant breakthrough, and we thanked the Lord for opening his understanding.

The following morning, we invited him to join us for breakfast at the place where we were staying. We spent another two hours together in warm Christian fellowship, discussing the Word and answering additional questions. Our relationship grew into a genuine friendship, and he expressed his desire for us to visit him every time we come to Dubai.

Today, Pastor Prashant has a much clearer understanding of the Message and is approximately 90% settled in its teachings. We remain in regular contact with him through WhatsApp, sending him study materials and encouraging him in his walk with the Lord. We have especially encouraged him to prayerfully read *Seven Church Ages*, believing that it will further strengthen his understanding of God's plan for this last age.

We thank the Lord for this open door and ask for your prayers that Pastor Prashant will continue to grow in the truth and stand firmly upon the full revelation of God's Word.

Ministry in the English Message Churches

The Lord graciously opened the door for us to minister in both of the English-speaking Message churches in the United Arab Emirates—one in Dubai and the other in Sharjah. It was a great privilege and blessing to fellowship with these precious believers and share the Word of God with them.

By the grace of God, I was given the opportunity to preach in both churches. We thank the Lord for these open doors of ministry and pray that He will continue to strengthen these congregations and use them to reach many more souls throughout the United Arab Emirates.

We are deeply grateful to all those who prayed for us and supported this mission. Your prayers were answered in many wonderful ways as the Lord directed every meeting and blessed every opportunity to minister. To God alone be all the glory.

This mission is far from complete. The follow-up work is just as important as the initial visit. Many of the believers and pastors we met are hungry for more fellowship and teaching. They are looking to us for spiritual guidance, encouragement, and continued instruction in the Word.

We earnestly ask you to continue remembering us in your prayers as we begin this important follow-up ministry. We are planning to return to Dubai as soon as the Lord makes a way so that we can strengthen these believers, answer their remaining questions, and keep the fire of revival burning in their hearts. Our desire is to see these precious brothers and sisters firmly established in the Message of the Hour and united in Christian fellowship.
